

## **SAR-Society for Artistic Research – Result of elections to the Executive Board**

Dear SAR members

We sent all representatives for institutional members and all paying individual members a link to the voting sheet on Monday March 30<sup>th</sup> in the evening. 120 emails with link to the voting sheet were distributed, this included one that was resent due to a misspelling of one email address. The voting ended on Friday April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 13.00.

We received 75 responses (votes). Unfortunately, only after the elections was closed, the election system informed that two messages had not been received. However, all the remaining 117 voters had the opportunity to cast their votes.

The voting sheet included the choice to endorse or reject that the elections could take place. 73 of the received votes endorsed the election procedure. We thus have a majority of the members endorsing the election procedure.
